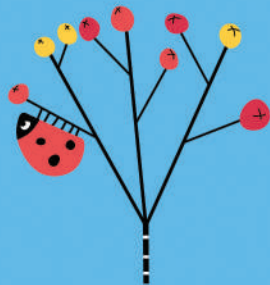
**As the raindrops reached the forest
